Show regulations and admission requirements:

Only dogs registered in the ÖKV studbook or in another studbook recognised by the FCI are permitted. Sick dogs or dogs suspected of being sick are excluded. The organiser accepts no liability for any damage caused by a dog, including the theft of a dog. Each exhibitor is liable for any damage caused by his dog. Dogs in the working dog class must pass a TSB test before being shown.

The "VA" rating can only be awarded to dogs that receive the highest rating of "a" (pronounced) for the TSB rating.

- Dogs with the predicate "vh" (present) or "ng" (not sufficient) can still take part in the competition.
- Dogs with a pass (T2) are placed at the end of the V group or with a fail (T3) at the end of the SG group.
- Dogs that do not release (T1), have a lack of obedience (T4) or are disqualified cannot take part in the rest of the competition.

Females may no longer be shown from the 42nd day of pregnancy. Lactating females may only be shown from the 70th day after the day of whelping.

From the age of 24 months (working dogs, open and veteran classes), only dogs with an HD/ED stamp entered in the pedigree with the rating "normal", "almost normal" or "still approved" (or A, B and C according to the FCI grid) are permitted.

Evaluation mirror:

"a" = TSB can be pronounced.

T1 = TSB does not drain

T2 = TSB present

T3 = TSB not sufficient

T4 = cancelled due to lack of leadership

DI = disqualified

Should a dog fall ill after it has been sampled, it must be presented to the official veterinarian who is present on the show grounds. An excused withdrawal is only possible on presentation of a written certificate from the veterinary surgeon or with the express authorisation of the officiating judge. The certificate of illness issued must be handed over to the officiating judge.

Dogs that are withdrawn without a valid excuse will receive an "unsatisfactory" rating and will be banned from events and banned from the studbook for a period of 6 months.

Only dogs are eligible for the winner's title and the **V selection (VA)**,

) that are licensed and have received the **TSB rating "pronounced" at licensing.**

(Dogs from abroad, where no licensing takes place, are excluded from this).

) that have a complete, perfect set of teeth.

) that carry at least the **FCI IGP 2** training mark.

) that originate from licence and performance breeding.

) that show a normal or almost normal HD status and a normal or almost normal ED status.

) the dog must not be inbred closer than 3-3, 4-2, 2-4

Dogs that are to enter the V selection class for the second time must bear the **FCI IGP 3** training mark, females the **FCI IGP 2** training mark.

Only dogs that have the HD "a" stamp and the ED stamp with the findings normal, almost normal or still approved in the pedigree and, if over 3 ½ years old, are licensed can receive a "V" in the working dog class. Excluded from this are dogs that are located abroad where no licensing takes place.

Only dogs that are bred no closer than 3-3, 4-2 or 2-4 can be awarded the winner's title.

Utility dog class:

Dogs in the working dog class must have successfully passed an SVÖ/SV character assessment or an equivalent recognised character assessment - valid from 1.1.2022 litter date

Dogs in the working dog class **must** have at least one of the following training characteristics:

- International Utility Dog Test (FCI IGP ZTP, FCI IGP 1-3)
- Herding dog test HGH
- International Tracking Dog Test (FCI IFH2)
- Agility test (A2)
- Obedience test (O2)
- Rescue dog test (RH-F, RH-FL, RH-T, RH-W, RH-L) - level B in each case
- Or a training licence plate recognised as equivalent - e.g. SV ZAP
- Service dog tests - also outside the SVÖ/SV areas

Open class:

Open class dogs do not have a training mark.

Offspring groups:

At least five dogs must be shown that can have both coat varieties. Dogs from the junior classes may also be shown. All dogs presented must be stand patterned. Within the group, they must be presented in the order of stock coat and then long stock coat.

Breeding groups:

A breeding group consists of a minimum of four and a maximum of five dogs from one kennel. All animals in the breeding group must be presented to the officiating judge as a closed group and have the same type of coat. The breeder is free to present several breeding groups if necessary. Judging of the breeding groups takes place on Sunday after the working dog class for females.

TSB - Review:

Registration on site is required for the TSB inspection. The order of the work is determined by the registration. The TSB test is carried out in accordance with point 6 (character test) of the valid licensing regulations.

Dogs that are particularly convincing in the TSB test are highlighted at the end of the gait test.

Official veterinary supervision:

Dogs brought onto the exhibition grounds must have been vaccinated against rabies at least 1 month beforehand and no more than 12 months ago. A corresponding vaccination certificate clearly stating the identity of the dog must be presented.

Other notes:

Only one owner can be named in the catalogue. The entry will only be accepted if proof of payment of the full entry fee is provided.

Privacy policy:

We would like to point out that the data provided will be processed electronically and printed in the exhibition catalogue. The result lists with the names of the owners will be published on the Internet. The data will be passed on to the SV (Verein für Deutsche Schäferhunde). Photographs will be taken at the event and the photos will also be published for internal club purposes without any compensation being claimed.
